Sketch stage and number targets in order of engagement. Paper targets should have one number for each round required. Designate reloads with an "R" between targets.



3. Find the most efficient route from the beginning to the end. Avoid places you don't need to go. Always strive to keep moving. Pause instead of stopping when your sight picture dictates less movement.

4. Visualize the perfect execution of the stage with an acceptable sight picture on every target. Continue to do this until you are called to the line.

5. At Make Ready, visualize the entire stage one more time after you load and take your sight pictures.

6. When you are ready, remind yourself that you are there to call every shot: **I am here to call every shot.**
